Stay At Home Order How will it apply to Our Church?

Premier Doug Ford issued a province-wide declaration of emergency and stay-at-home order effective Thursday, April 8th. We encourage you to visit Ontario.ca and the Wellington, Dufferin Guelph Public Health website (wdgpublichealth.ca) for additional information. The following is a summary of how our Church will be affected.

RELIGIOUS GATHERINGS

Under ONTARIO REGULATION 11/21, section 3 religious gatherings are allowed and residents of Ontario may leave their homes to attend religious gatherings. "Attending a gathering for the purpose of a wedding, a funeral or a religious service, rite or

| different capacity limits. |
| ☐ Previous guidelines on cleaning and disinfecting stay |
| in place. |
| ☐ All meeting and event spaces are closed. |
