St. Francis of Assisi

St. Francis is one of the most venerated religious figures in Roman Catholic history. He founded the Franciscan orders, including the Poor Clares and the lay Third Order. He and St. Catherine of Siena are the patron saints of Italy, and he is also the patron saint of ecology and of animals. Francis considered all nature as the mirror of God. He called all creatures his "brothers" and "sisters," and, in the most endearing stories about him, preached to the birds. For the past several years, the Franciscan Fraternity of Guelph has provided packets of seeds which are to be scattered to feed the birds in celebration of Christmas. The packets will arrive in the coming weeks and you will find them in the Narthex. Please take one and feed the birds - its an excellent activity to do as a family!

Charitable Status of Pro-Life Organizations at Risk

The Liberal party has promised that "a re-elected Liberal government will no longer provide charity status to anti-abortion organizations (for example Crisis Pregnancy Centres)." If acted upon, crisis pregnancy centres and pro-life educational organizations will lose their charitable status, including Guelph & Area Right to Life and Sanctuary Outreach. How can you help? Kindergarten Registration at Wellington Catholic DSB

The Wellington Catholic District School Board will be accepting new registrations for kindergarten at our schools beginning January 3, 2022.

To be eligible for registering in kindergarten, children;

- must be four years of age on or before December 31, 2022 to attend Junior (Year 1) Kindergarten
- must be five years of age on or before December 31, 2022 to attend Senior (Year 2) Kindergarten

During the registration process, school administration is available to assist you with any questions you may have. To assist administrators with registering your child for kindergarten, we ask that you have the following documents available;

- · Child's Birth Certificate
- · Parent Or Child's Baptismal Certificate
- Proof of Tax Support for Families New to the System (i.e. Most Recent Tax Bill)
- Proof of Address (Government Document, Mortgage or Rental Agreement, Hydro Bill, Credit Card Statement)
- Immigration Documentation (If Applicable)
- Custody Documents (If Applicable)

Please note:

- Students currently attending a Wellington Catholic Junior (Year 1) Kindergarten program are **NOT REQUIRED** to register for Senior (Year 2) Kindergarten.
- Should you have any questions about registration procedures or requirements, contact your local school.
