Kindergarten at Wellington Catholic... We have faith in education

The Wellington Catholic District School Board will be accepting registrations for Kindergarten at our schools beginning January 9th, 2023.

Kindergarten Eligibility

- must be four years of age on or before December 31, 2023, to attend Year 1 Kindergarten
- must be five years of age on or before December 31, 2023, to attend Year 2 Kindergarten

Documents needed:

- child's birth certificate
- a parent or child's Baptismal certificate
- proof of tax support for families new to the system (i.e. most recent tax bill)
- proof of address (government document, mortgage, or rental agreement, Hydro bill, credit card statement)
- proper immigration documentation
- custody documents (if applicable)

Please note:

 Students currently attending a Wellington Catholic Year 1 Kindergarten program are <u>NOT REQUIRED</u> to register for Year 2 Kindergarten. Should you have any questions about registration procedures or requirements, please call your school.
