From the Pastor's Desk

Today is Sunday of the Word of God. It is also sometimes called Bible Sunday. In 2020, Pope Francis declared that the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time was to be devoted to the celebration, study, and dissemination of the Word of God "that the life of our people be constantly marked by this decisive relationship with the living Word that the Lord never tires of speaking to his Bride." (Aperuit Illis, 2)

Pope Francis says, we need God's Word, so, that we can hear, amid the thousands of other words in our daily lives, that one Word that speaks to us not about things, but about life. May I add, also, about love. Yes, the Word of God is a love letter from God to humanity. The Word of salvation does not go looking only for untouched, clean, and safe places. Instead, it enters the complex and obscure places in our lives. Pope Francis reminds us that "the word of God should be read daily and kept at hand even on our cellphones."

Those that are ministers of the Word and indeed all baptized Christians must undergo continual formation and personal study of the Word of God. Until the Word of God rules our hearts, we can never expect it to rule the world. The basic way to foster this is to read the Bible itself. Read! Read! Read! The People of God must not only be told of the Word of God, but they themselves must drink from the wellspring itself—the Bible.

We must realize that discipleship begins when the Word of God is proclaimed, but more importantly received, that is, when it is swallowed, digested, and reaches the heart of the hearer. This will then lead to conversion.

To highlight the importance of the Word of God, I will be giving a special blessing to all our ministers of the Word—our lectors after the homily at all Masses this weekend. Let us daily make room in our lives for the Word of God!
