As the story is told, it happened in a typical church. A 'nice' church! A 'respectable' church! One Sunday morning, a man walked into the church, but he just did not seem to belong. He was scruffy in appearance and his clothes were ragged. He smelled of beer, which judging from his unsteady walk, he had consumed in great quantity the night before.

An usher acknowledges the man with a half-hearted nod motioning him toward an out-of-the way pew. Ignoring his suggestion, the visitor staggered down the centre aisle to the front pew, and planted himself there. So far, so good, thought the usher—that is, until the pastor began his sermon.

ReSTART: Moving Forward


