## From the Pastor's Desk

Writer Kathleen Norris was a guest at a Catholic monastery some twenty-five years, or so ago, when the members of the 'Heaven's Gate' cult all committed suicide based on their strange belief about events connected with the appearance of Comet Hale-Bopp. Norris heard the news in the monastery and noted that the members of that cult had referred to themselves as 'monks.' However, she later wrote that the 'Heaven's Gate' devotees did not seem much like the monks she knew, for she found the monasteries to be hospitable places, welcoming guests, whereas this cult did not tolerate outsiders. She noted that St. Benedict, who wrote the Rule of Benedict, said: "A monastery is never without guests." She also added that, "What Benedict says might be seen as a way to define a monastery—if it regularly exercises enough hospitality so as to attract guests, it is a monastery, if it doesn't it is not." A similar definition could be used as part of what it means to be a church or a parish. If it regularly exercises enough hospitality to make newcomers and regular attendees feel welcome, it is a church or a parish, if it doesn't, it is not. How is St. Joseph Parish, Fergus, doing? Have we said 'hello' or 'welcomed' a newcomer or an oldtimer lately? It is never too late to start!
