From the Pastor's Desk Fr. Robert Hétu

I do not watch too much TV, but several years ago, I had an opportunity to view for the first time the two-hour special finale of M\*A\*S\*H. I found it very thought provoking.

I remembered that in the early years of this long running television series there was a constant verbal battle raging between Hawkeye and Frank Burns. Hawkeye was cynical, razor-tongue and unrepentantly non-conformist. Frank, on the other hand, was pressed and starched—an all-military type of guy, and hypercritical of everyone around him, especially his subordinates. As is often true for the hypercritical, Frank was not very self-reflective.

In one episode the camp is under siege by a sniper. As bullets fly back and forth across the compound, Hawkeye and Frank have a moment to discuss the persistent presence of death, especially in times of war. We must realize, however, that the presence of death is not only a fact of war, but it is a fact of everyday life.

The season of Lent is a time when we are on the road from crucifixion and to resurrection. This is not a road we are called to travel on our own, but a road on which we follow Jesus—the one who is on the way to the cross. On his way to the cross, Jesus helps his disciples understand that death and dying (because of original sin) are part of life. We must incorporate this reality into our daily lives as well, in order to be fully faithful to our calling. As people of faith, we should not be afraid of death and dying. Let us boldly prepare for out heavenly journey. May we always rejoice in the glory and victory of the cross!
