Born in Kitchener to Dr. Willard Anthony Sehl, MD, and Norma Ann (nee Coughlin), BHSc.

Brother of Eleanor (Bob) Buchanan of Kitchener, Margaret Sehl of Guelph and Thomas Sehl (Therese) of Waterdown. Also missed by his 9 nephews and nieces, David (Jennifer) and Heather Buchanan, Joel and Daniel Densmore, Rachel (Magnus), Peter (Lindsey), Hannah, Bethany (Tawab) and Jonathan Sehl, and by his 3 great nieces Kristian (aka Kady) Buchanan, Madelyn and Eleanor Sehl.

Fr. Terry was educated beyond his intelligence at St. Mary's Separate, St. Jerome's High School, Resurrection College, University of Waterloo (B.A. Philosophy), St. Augustine's Seminary (Sacred Theology), University of Ottawa (MEd Administration), Pope St. John XXIII Seminary in Weston (Boston), Massachusetts (MDiv).

He then received his Ontario Elementary Teacher's Certificate and taught in Elfrieda, Kitchener, Galt, and Hespeler for the next 20 years.

He indulged his love of the natural world by taking many trips overseas, cruises and many, many canoe trips into the wilderness of Northern Ontario and Canada's High Arctic. The ultimate trip was into the Nahanni River Valley, a place where one can sense the existence of God and experience His power, majesty and beauty.

Upon his return, he began his second career by studying theology by entering Pope St. John XXIII Seminary in Weston, Massachusetts leading to the great day of ordination on May 4, 1991 at the Basilica Cathedral of Christ the King in Hamilton by Bishop A.F. Tonnos D.D.

He then served in parishes in Guelph, Galt, Milton, Linwood (Macton), Kitchener, Mildmay (Carlsruhe). During his time in Kitchener, he ran for and was elected handily two times as a trustee of the Waterloo District Catholic School Board and served for 5 years. He retired from full time ministry to his tiny cottage home "Tullamore" on Lake Belwood.
