#### From the Pastor's Desk

Dr. Joe Vitale reminds us that behind every behaviour Is a belief. Whenever we are confused about why we did something, Dr. Vitale suggests that we look for a 'belief.' Beliefs compel us to do what we might otherwise think is stupid. "The belief isn't stupid. It's just a belief. Change the belief and you change the behaviour."

Most people will have no clue that their behaviour comes from their own beliefs. They will want to blame others – the prime minister, the economy, their family (especially their parents,) their friends, their childhood, and so on. Blame is easy. It avoids responsibility. Recognizing that all behaviour is caused by a belief will help us select better beliefs for ourselves. It will also help us to understand others as well.

In today's Gospel parable, Jesus has a landowner who is very generous with his resources. The landowner chose to pay each worker the agreed upon daily wage even those that worked only a half a day or even just an hour. Some of the other workers believed that they should have been paid more, but the landowner responded, "Am I not allowed to do what I choose with what belongs to me? Or are you envious because I am generous?"

We need to express our gratitude to God in our daily lives. God personally calls each one of us to our own ministry and shows us God's care by giving us God's grace and offering us eternal salvation. To God, like the landowner in today's Gospel, we are more than just numbers on a payroll. Our call to God's vineyard is a free gift from God for which we can never be sufficiently thankful. Let us rejoice, and not be envious, in the success and blessings of others. We need to follow God's example and unconditional love to our families, friends, and neighbours.


