From the Pastor's Desk

In today's Gospel, Jesus compares the growth of the Kingdom of God to the germination of a wheat seed and that of a tiny mustard seed. Both have very small beginnings. The wheat seeds, by gradual but steady growth, give the farmer a bumper crop. In the same way, the life principle in a tiny mustard seed enables it to grow into a large bush. The reign of God in human hearts and the growth of the Church in the world also have small beginnings. Yet, the source of all life, God the Holy Spirit, gives to both a steady, persistent and gigantic growth, provided we co-operate with God's grace.

Since the acceptance God's rule by human beings is a very slow process, there is a great danger of discouragement and hopelessness among preachers, evangelizers and believers. Yet, we need not get discouraged. The conviction that growth of the Kingdom of God is the work of the Holy Spirit with our humble cooperation should make us optimistic in continuing our work of witnessing. We should continue sowing tiny seeds in the form of words of love, acts of encouragement, deeds of charity, mercy and forgiveness. Remember parents, teachers, and mentors can plant a lot of seeds in the minds of their children and students. The Holy Spirit will touch the hearts of the recipients of these seeds sown by us and will affect the growth of the Kingdom in their souls and lives. As the apostle Paul said of his ministry, in 1 Corinthians 3:7, "Neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth."


