A priest was asked to visit a young woman in the hospital. He did not know her, but he was told that she had not lived a very moral life, and that she was dying. She was now quite concern about God's judgement, and she asked the priest if God was against her. He answered, "No, God is for you but against your sins. She died a few days later, but in her last hours, she had told the nurse to thank the priest, and to tell him that she had joyfully made her peace with God.

God both cares for us and judges us, however, unlike human judges; God also provides mercy and grace. No matter whether we deserve light or harsh judgement, the Father sent Jesus—the Son, to tell us about forgiveness so that if we accept it, we have nothing to fear in the final judgement. As we attempt to come closer to our God, let us take comfort in the promise of the gift of heavenly joy. May our prayer this third week of Advent be, "Lord, fill us with joy."
