From the Pastor's Desk

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord is not only an ancient feast, which ends the Christmas Season; it also should have a profound theological meaning for all Christians. It has implications for our lives and our mission.

Last week on the Feast of the Epiphany of our Lord, as I mentioned in my homily, in the Western Church, we remembered the 'manifestation' of Jesus to the Gentiles. We reflected on the "wise men from the East" who followed the light of the star to the fullness of divinity, who humbled himself to share in our humanity. Yet, from antiquity, the Church has pointed to the 'epiphany in the water' this 'manifestation' in the river Jordan, at the baptism of Jesus, as the event wherein the full plan of God for the Church and the entirety of creation itself is made manifest.

The Baptism of Jesus, this great 'Theophany,' therefore, speaks to the very meaning and mystery of the vocation of the Church and of every Christian. We are called to be immersed in God and to bring the world along. As we renew our baptismal promises, and plunge anew into the fount of living water, let us begin here and now to live our lives, immersed in God, so we can be a light for others in the darkness of our world.
