From the Pastor's Desk



A young father was widowed and left with his six-year-old daughter. He had a hard time working through his own grief, but admitted that the hardest part was trying to comfort and explain the death of his wife to his daughter. Even with all he knew, he was left at a loss.

Who can receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick?

Any member of the faithful can receive this sacrament as soon as he or she begins to be in danger of death because of sickness or old age. They do not need to be in imminent danger of dying. It is appropriate to be anointed before a medical procedure. The faithful who receive this sacrament can receive it several times if their illness becomes worse or another serious sickness afflicts them. The celebration of this sacrament should, if possible, be preceded by individual confession on the part of the sick person.


