

From the Pastor's Desk


One day a truck driver stopped at a restaurant for dinner and ordered a steak. However, before he could eat it, in walked a motorcycle gang, with dirty leather jackets and long, unkempt hair. They took the man's steak, cut it into six pieces, and ate it. The driver said nothing. He simply paid the bill and walked out. One of the gang members said, "That man couldn't talk. He didn't say a word." Another one said, "He couldn't fight, either; he didn't lift a hand." A waiter added, "I would say that he couldn't drive either. On his way out of the parking lot, he ran over six motorcycles crushing all of them." Something in us loves that story, because we like retaliation. Yet, in the Sermon on the Mount Jesus prescribes forgiving love as the Christian trump card.

In today's Gospel, Jesus says that we must "love our enemies." What does that mean? Does it mean we must feel affection for them? No. it means that we must treat them as well as we treat people we like. We must be kind and respectful to them. We must not treat them badly. We must put their needs before ours.

Proverbs says, "A soft answer turns away wrath." (15:1) Yes, it is difficult for bullies to continue to be mean and disrespectful, if we do not let them get us angry. It takes the fun away from them. So, the advice of is Jesus is not only the better way to handle the situation from God's end, but also from our end. May we be "merciful and gracious!" (Psalm 103)
