

From the Pastor's Desk



Corrie ten Boom was a woman who, during World War II, worked with the Dutch underground. Corrie, her sister Betsie, and their elderly father were all Christians. As a result, they felt that they should help all those who came to their door fleeing the Nazi terror. The trio started helping Jews and were soon running a virtual hotel for those who needed a place to hide. Sadly, the ten Booms were eventually discovered and imprisoned. The sisters were separated from their father and sent to Ravensbrück, the death camp, where they lived in horrendous conditions. In time, Mr. Ten

Boom and Betsie died in the camps, but Corrie

survived.

In one of her books. Corrie tells about the last time she saw her father. As she and her sister were being lead away, they passed a room where they saw her father seated, waiting to learn his own fate. "Father," Corrie cried out, "God be with you!" The old man responded, "And with you my daughters." The sisters were not merely expressing a wish or hope that God would be with their father, and he was not merely responding in kind. No. All three of them were being prophetic. No matter how terrible their immediate future, no matter whether they lived or died, they were confident that God would be with them. That is the prophetic confidence. (Corrie ten Boom, The Hiding Place, 130-131.)

Let us be inspired by Corrie, Betsie and their father and like the disciples in today's Gospel, "They left everything and followed Jesus." In the footsteps of the prophet Isaish as see in our first reading today, the Lord said, "Whom shall I send?" May respond. "Here I am: send me!"


