

From the Pastor's Desk

The Venerable Archbishop Fulton Sheen had often suggested that there is a new dirty word in Christianity. This new dirty word does not have four letters but five. Sadly, the word is C R O S S! I am sure that there are many who would prefer the idea of Jesus and no cross. Yet. Jesus took this absurd symbol of the cross, put himself on it, and solved the mystery of life and death. Paradoxically, Jesus solved death by making the cross a condition of life, the crown of thorns a condition for a royal crown of victory, and the scourged body a condition for a glorified body. In simple words, Jesus conquered pain and death by using them as a means of attaining glory and eternal life. We must die with Jesus if we want to rise with Jesus. Writer Paula D'Arcy reminds us that, "The power of love is greater than the power of pain."

Avoiding the cross is the essence of the demonic. It is the heart of the devil's trap and the devil's greatest temptation. So, the challenge for us is to "take up our cross daily and follow him." Yes. Good Friday with the Cross is a necessary condition for Easter Sunday. Did you ever wonder why we call the day that remember the death of Jesus—Good Friday? It is because, by God's grace, the cross and death of Jesus is good for us since we know the ending of the story; the gift of the Resurrection and his/our Easter victory. This Lent, along side Jesus, let us claim his/our victory over Satan. In this Jubilee Year of Hope, let us all become God's instruments of hope and "Lift high the cross."




