From the Pastor's Desk



Traditionally, the Fourth Sunday of Lent is called Laetare Sunday (Rejoice Sunday). Anticipating Easter joy, today's readings invite us to rejoice by being reconciled with God through repentance and the confession of our sins and by celebrating our coming home to be with our loving and forgiving God.

In the first reading, the Chosen People of God are portrayed as celebrating, for the first time in their own land, the feast of their freedom, by using wheat that had grown in the Promised Land.

In the second reading, St. Paul invites the Corinthian Christian community to rejoice because Jesus has reconciled them with God, the Father, by his suffering and death.

Today's Gospel celebrates the joy of the prodigal son on his 'homecoming' as he rediscovers his father's forgiving and overflowing love. It is also the story of the rejoicing of a loving and forgiving father who celebrates the return of his prodigal son by throwing a big party in his honour, a banquet celebrating the reconciliation of the son with his father, his family, his community and God. At the same time, by presenting a self-righteous elder brother, the parable invites us to avoid self-justification by imitating the repentant younger brother. Let us admit the truth that we are an assembly of sinful people, ready to receive God's forgiveness and to experience the personal and real presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist; who is a loving and forgiving God. In Holy Communion, we participate in the banquet of reconciliation, thus restoring our full relationship with God, the Father, and our fellow human beings.

In this Jubilee Year of Hope, let us truly be instruments of hope. With hope and gratitude, let us boldly 'lift high the Cross.'




