

#### From the Pastor's Desk

Today's Gospel passage, or parts of it, is often used at funeral liturgies. Jesus reminds Martha that her "brother will rise again." And Martha, despite her personal lost and pain, still acknowledges, "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection on the last day." Jesus goes on to remind her that, "I am the resurrection and the life. Those who believe in me, even though they die, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die."

As our Lenten journey draws to a close, the Lord asks us the same question he asked Martha, "Do you believe this?" What will our answer be? And how will/does our life reflect that answer? Lent is a time to re-evaluate our 'raison d'être' and our life's ambition. Like Martha may we proclaim from the depth of our being, "Yes, Lord, I believe that you are the Messiah, the Son of God, the one coming into the world." By God's grace, may we be instruments of peace, love and reconciliation within our families, our parish community and beyond.

In this *Jubilee Year of Hope*, may we be God's instruments filled with hope. With hope and gratitude, let us boldly 'lift high the Cross.'
