#### From the Pastor's Desk



St. Augustine considered the Feast of the Ascension the crown of all Christian festivals. The Ascension, however, like the Cross, is somewhat paradoxical. Jesus is physically leaving us behind (which seems bad) to return to the Father (which is very good). Jesus no longer walks among us, yet as we heard last Sunday, he will not leave us orphaned. Jesus returns to the Father to send us another Advocate—the Holy Spirit.

The mission of Jesus would not be complete until he returned to the Father, where he is preparing a dwelling place for us. That ultimately is why Jesus became one of us in the first place, so that he could save us from our death of sin and invite us to share in his Resurrection and new life in heaven.

In the word if St. Teresa of Avila, "[Jesus] Christ has no body but yours, no hands, no feet on earth but yours, yours are the eyes with which he looks compassion on this world, yours are the feet with which he walks to do good, yours are the hands, with which he blesses all the world. Yours are the hands, yours are the feet, yours are the eyes, and you are his body."

With the grace of the indwelling Spirit—let us be Jesus on earth and Temples of the Holy Spirit in our world. As the Apostles shared the Good News let us follow in their footsteps.
