Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. St. Paul, in his First Letter to the Corinthians, asked these two rhetorical questions. "The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not the sharing in the Blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a sharing in the Body of Christ?" On this special day, what do these words really mean to us? The Church teaches and as Catholics, we are called to believe that the bread and wine blessed by Jesus at the Last Supper, and through the priest or bishop at every Mass, truly is the Body and Blood of Christ. Personally, do we really believe that when we go to communion, we receive Jesus? That is what our 'Amen' declares!

Today, (on Sunday, June 22), all parishioners, family and friends are invited to join the Wellington Deanery Eucharistic Procession a celebration of our faith in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. Following a 2pm Mass at the Basilica of Our Lady Immaculate, the procession will begin around 3:20pm, making its way to Sacred Heart Church. The event will conclude with Solemn Benediction and followed by a reception with light refreshments.

Blest with the gift of faith, what effect does this doctrine have in our lives? How different is our daily living because we believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist? When I came to truly believe and understand the Real Presence of Jesus is the Eucharist as a teenager, my life was changed for ever! Do we desire to receive Jesus often? Weekly? Daily?

On this Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, let the awesome news that we can receive Jesus—the Bread of Life—as food for our souls for ever change us. As the saying goes, "You are what you eat." O Jesus-Bread of Life feed my soul for eternity. Amen.


