From the Pastor's Desk

There is a story about a man who was shipwrecked on an island for 10 years. During that time, he kept sane by creating an entire town. including a house, a grocery store (with empty shelves of course), a movie theatre (with no movies), and a church at each end of his Main Street, out of palm branches.

When he was finally rescued, he was asked why he made two churches. Pointing to one he said, "That's where I went, even though I sat alone, to remind myself that I am part of a Body of Christ that extends around the world.
