From the Pastor's Desk

Some good news. "Let us rejoice and be glad." (Psalm 118) Earlier this month I received the following memo from Bishop Crosby.

Grace and peace in the Lord Jesus Christ.

In his New Year's message, the late Pope Francis spoke of our current Jubilee Year of Hope: "May we seek the true peace that is granted by God to hearts disarmed: hearts not set on calculating what is mine and what is yours; hearts that turn selfishness into readiness to reach out to others; hearts that see themselves as indebted to God and thus prepared to forgive the debts that oppress others; hearts that replace anxiety about the future with the hope that every individual can be a resource for the building of a better world."

Since the times of Leviticus and Deuteronomy, the forgiveness of debts has been a central pillar of the great tradition of Jubilee. In this same spirit and in the hopes of offering the hope of being set free from prohibitive debt, I am pleased to share with you that I have forgiven your Parish debt in the terms outlined below. \$266,366 of St. Joseph's \$296,492 Parish Cathedraticum owing to the Diocese has been forgiven. I ask you to share this information with your Parish community and that this may build the spirit of solidarity and fraternal communion contemplated by this Jubilee Year of Hope.

My hope is that this freedom from debt may further enable you to bring the hope of the Gospel to all of those entrusted to your care.

Heroes of Hope is a monthly newsletter from the Diocese of Hamilton, shining a light on the extraordinary individuals and ministries who inspire hope and transform lives in our communities.

#HEROESOFHOPE

Since the pandemic, accompanying young people has become an increasing priority across the Diocese of Hamilton. Many have stepped forward to walk with them in faith: parish priests, seminarians, youth ministers, parish staff, and dedicated volunteers. It truly does take a community to accompany a young person in their pilgrimage of faith.

The tireless work of these individuals often goes unnoticed, but these individuals always ensure there are opportunities for young people to engage with their community and encounter Christ. Through their mentorship and advocacy, they guide young people by witnessing to their faith. The faith of young people is nurtured in communities where they are seen, heard, and supported.



Youth in Parish Life

Our parish communities create spaces of welcome and encouragement by involving young people in the life of the parish. Young people infuse life and vibrancy into our parishes through youth led Masses, youth bands and choirs, and opportunities to be lectors, altar servers, and members of hospitality teams. The accompaniment of young people is unique to each parish shaped by the young people themselves and their needs. Many parishes have Children's Liturgy, Vacation Bible School, and Youth Groups. Young people participate in parish programs in preparation for First Communion and Confirmation.

"Anyone called to be a parent, pastor or guide to young people must have the farsightedness to appreciate the little flame that continues to burn, the fragile reed that is shaken but not broken (cf. Is 42:3). The ability to discern pathways where others only see walls, to recognize potential where others see only peril: that is how God the Father see things; he knows how to cherish and nurture the seeds of goodness sown in the hearts of the young. Each young person's heart should thus be considered 'holy ground'...."


