From the Pastor's Desk

On September 4, 2017, Pope Francis officially declared the loving, humble, and merciful Mother Teresa of Calcutta as a saint of the Roman Catholic Church. This glorious event reminded me of an article I read written by Charles Barton in the *Bread of Life* magazine entitled: *Ambassadors of the King*. Barton reminds us that it is hard to stand for what is honest, true and right. It is hard because in taking a stand, we know that we will encounter resistance. Some people may not understand and others will laugh at us. Still others may hate what we say and do and will work against us. We may be isolated, bullied and put down We might want to run away. Yet, where can we run to? What is needed is courage.

How do we find our courage? Like St. Peter, after the resurrection of Jesus, we need to answer the Lord's question, "Do you love me?" Barton reminds us that it is a fundamental question. We must in our heart of hearts say our own, "Yes!" Then, as St. Peter did, we must accept our commission, to go out into the world and be ambassadors for Christ. As ambassadors, we need to spread the Good News, share the love of Christ, and be humble instruments of mercy to all those we meet. Pope Francis tells us: "Mercy does not just mean being a 'good person' nor is it mere sentimentality. It is the measure of our authenticity as disciples of Jesus."

When we have said our personal 'yes.' When we have loved others. When we have humbly reached out to help the downtrodden. When we have shown mercy. We will receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit to strengthen us. As Charles Barton has suggested: "Even if we are as small and feeble as Mother of Teresa of Calcutta, we can stand against any foe, any Goliath, and the Lord will be our strength!" Saint Teresa of Calcutta pray for us.
