Amy Carmichael (1867-1951) had a distinguished and fruitful ministry in india for many years. As the bold founder and the heart of the dahnavur fellowship, she had been instrumental in rescuing hundreds of boys and girls from horrific life of servitude and sexual exploitation. While she performed her rescue operations and brought young people into spiritual freedom through faith in jesus christ, she wrote books and poems that are still blessing readers around the world today.

Even thought an unfortunate serious car accident made her an invalid, she never bemoaned her affliction or questioned God. Amy continued to be the guiding inspiration of the fellowship, and she still kept writing. Her meditations, letters and poems are filled with praise to God and encouragement to fellow pilgrims.

When affliction strikes us, how do we react? Are we miserable and embittered? Or, do we trust God and appreciate God's sustaining grace? Are we a source of encouragement for others by our courage and confidence in God? When we rely on the Lord, the Lord will help us turn pain into praise. Praise is the song of a soul set free. I leave you with these poetic words of wisdom from Amy Carmichael: "Every night, however long and difficult, ends in a dawn of gold."


