# From the Pastor's Desk

Today is *The World Day of the Poor* and its theme is "You are my hope" (Psalm 71:5) It is a relatively new celebration, on the Catholic calendar, created by Pope Francis at the end of the *Jubilee Year of Mercy*. So, on Sunday. November 16, we celebrate the ninth World Day of the Poor, which coincides with our Jubilee Year of Hope. Pope Leo XIV has highlighted that the poor can be "witnesses to a strong and steadfast hope" and has encouraged new initiatives to combat poverty.

Pope Leo XIV's in this year's message reminds us and he links: *Hope and poverty*: The pope has emphasized that the poor, despite their difficult circumstances, embody a profound hope that is not based on material possessions. The pope goes: *Beyond charity*: He has called for actions beyond simple charity, advocating for structural changes to provide security in areas like housing, education, and healthcare. The pope's message also reminds us of the: *Dignity of the poor*. He urges Christians to see the poor not as objects of charity, but as protagonists of hope and as brothers and sisters in Christ.

This year the Diocese of Hamilton have established a special Jubilee Year of Hope collection. At St. Joseph's Parish, it will take place on the weekend of November 29-30 and envelopes will be provided. Monies collected, with the assistance of the St. Vincent de Paul Society, will be shared with our local poor.

As Sarah Escobar encourages us in today's Sunday Missal, "On this World of the Poor, let us make the poor a priority in our lives and strive to love Our Lord in all we meet."
