

From the Pastor's Desk

A mission team from a church in Ohio traveled to a financially depressed area of eastern Kentucky where they helped to build a house for a low-income family. When they arrived, they found that the concrete footer for the house had been poured the previous week by another work team, so the first job of the new team was to lay up the foundation, using cement blocks. They were working under the direction of a professional builder, and he did not just hand out trowels and tell the team to go at it. Instead, he first set the blocks in all four corners, to the full height of the foundation. Next, he laid the first row of blocks all the way around. Then, and only then, did he let the team members lay blocks.

What the builder had done is make sure that the cornerstones were square and true and the first round of blocks was set properly. That way, he assured that the amateurs on the team would not get the blocks too far away from where things were supposed to be to build a proper house. Get the corners right, and the rest can line up with that. That was the cornerstone lesson.

The team also learned about stumbling blocks. As some of the members worked directly on the foundation, other team members mixed the mortar and still others carried the block to the wall. The problem was, if they did not place them just right, those working on the walls tripped over them. The blocks were a nuisance underfoot.

We are called to be building blocks in God's kingdom, but if we do not respond, we can become stumbling blocks in the way of others working for the Lord. In this week of prayer for Christian unity, let us work together for the betterment of God's Kingdom here on earth. Let us follow the example of Jesus. So, are we building blocks or stumbling blocks?

Kindergarten Registration at Wellington Catholic DSB

The Wellington Catholic District School Board is now accepting new registrations for Kindergarten students! Our two-year Kindergarten program allows our young learners to learn, grow, and explore through play and inquiry in a faith-based environment.

Children who were born in 2022 may attend Year One Kindergarten (Junior Kindergarten), and children born in 2021 may attend Year Two Kindergarten (Senior Kindergarten). If your child is currently attending Year One with Wellington Catholic DSB, you do not have to re-register for Year Two at the same school. We invite families to register their child for Kindergarten by following these steps:

- **Find your school.** Visit findmyschool.ca find your local Catholic school using your home address
- **Pre-Register.** Complete the [online pre-registration form](http://wellingtoncdsb.ca) available at wellingtoncdsb.ca. Once submitted, you will receive a unique registration code by email. Use the code and link provided to complete the online registration forms
- **Schedule a meeting with school administration.** Book a meeting with the school to meet the staff, submit required documents, and finalize your child's admission
