Are Your Affairs in Order?

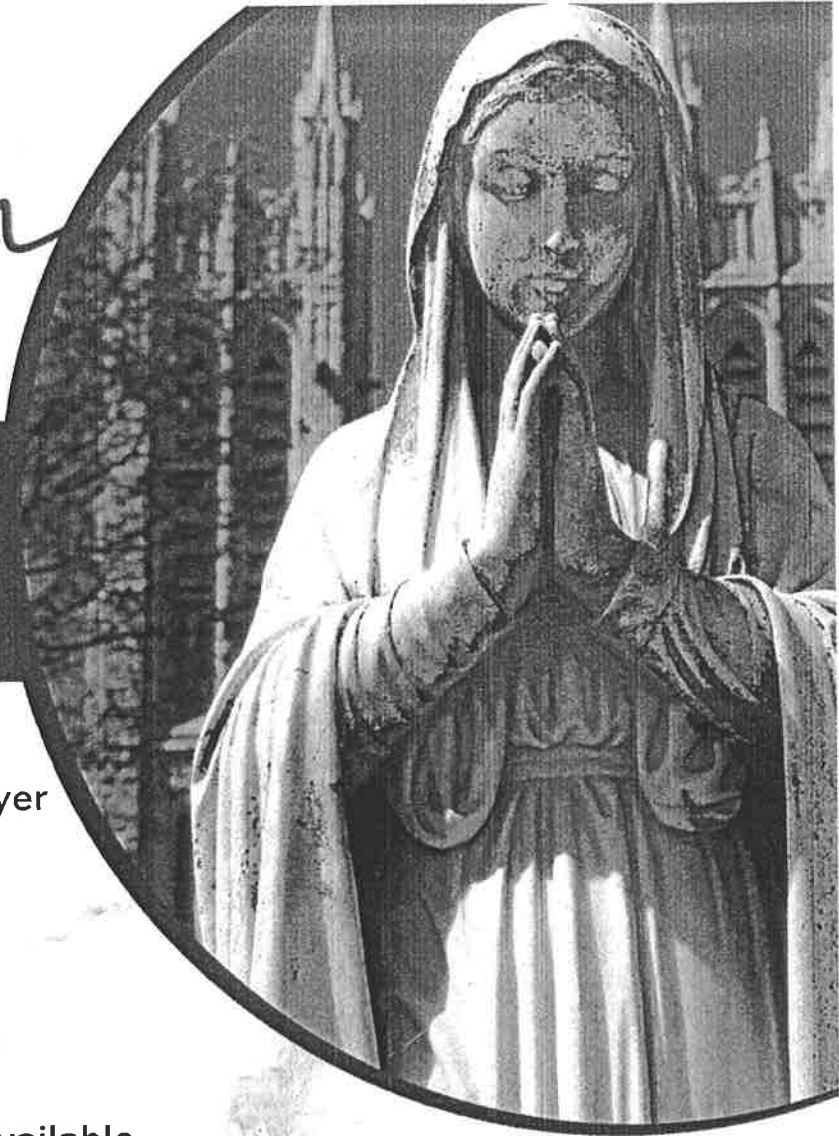
